*The purchase of the "Entrance with Audio Guide" ticket does not include access to the Liberian Museum Centre areas.

The audio tracks of the audio guide service are available in the following languages: Italian, English, Spanish, French and German.

HEARPHONES

If you wish to give an explanation within the perimeter of the Basilica and along the routes that are part of the Liberian Museum Centre, it is mandatory to use only and exclusively the earphones provided by the official dealer. The use of other audio devices will NOT be permitted.



NOTICE:

Earphones are mandatory for groups of 8 or more participants. It will be possible to rent the devices respecting the opening hours of the Reception Desk.

Service Fee:

The regulation authorizes the explanation and therefore the rental of earphones only in the presence of:

o **Guide:** regularly authorized to practice the profession and therefore equipped with a special card;

o **Teachers:** on a school and/or university visit upon presentation on the day of the visit of a letter on headed paper from the School and/or University Institute to which they belong;

o **Priests and/or religious figures of reference:** on a visit with groups of pilgrims only upon presentation on the day of the visit of a letter from the Parish to which they belong.
